

English

This term we will be writing descriptive pieces, flashback narratives, letters and diaries—all related to WWII. We will be reading 'Holes' in Guided Reading and our class read this is 'Letter from the Lighthouse'. We will also, of course, continue to strengthen our SPaG knowledge.

Music

Maths

History & Geography
