

English

This term we will be writing descriptive pieces, flashback narratives, letters and diaries—all related to WWII. We will be reading 'When Hitler Stole Pink Rabbit' in Guided Reading and our class read this is 'Letter from the Lighthouse'. We will also, of course, continue to strengthen our SPaG knowledge.

Maths

This term will be furthering our knowledge of place value, the four operations and fractions. We will be taking a Mastery approach to this and placing an emphasis on reasoning and problem solving.

History & Geography

Our topic focus this term will be on WWII. We will be learning about how the war started, countries involved and their locations, The Blitz, evacuees, rationing, the Holocaust and other key events.

We will be looking at the food of WWII and thinking about why some recipes were popular during that period.

Music

We will be learning some WWII songs and thinking about the impact music had during the war. We will also be practicing ready for Young Voices.

Spanish

We will be learning how to tell the time and describe the seasons.

Art

Using modelling and building skills, we will be creating our own model Anderson Shelters.

Computing

We will be cracking codes and learning about the amazing work of WWII code crackers, including Alan Turing and those who worked at Bletchley Park.

PE

We will begin the year by developing skills in tag rugby and gymnastics/dance. Throughout all of this, we will work on teamwork and leadership skills as well as how to develop tactics.

RE

During the first half-term we will be answering the question 'Why do Hindus want to be good?' and then 'Was Jesus the Messiah?' during the second half-term.
