How we use the Sport Funding

The school receives additional money for physical education (PE) and sport. The funding is to be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision.

Canon Pyon C of E Academy is free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the PE and sport provision. The overarching aim is to increase participation in PE and sport so all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of. This can include training for staff and teachers; providing additional opportunities for children to participate in sport; purchasing specialist equipment and enhancing the PE curriculum to engage all learners.

How we will measure the impact

4. An increase in participation in after school clubs and sports in general. This will come from club registers and feedback from specialist coaches and teachers.
